Thought for Today

Prayer – a struggle.

In today's Gospel reading Jesus tells a striking parable in which a widow pesters a judge until he makes a judgement in her favour. This would have caused amusement among the crowd. A widow, normally at that time thought to be someone poor and vulnerable, is angry and aggressive. The judge does not care for justice, has no interest in this woman, and yet, in the end, grants her request, why, simply because he wants a good night's sleep. Jesus suggests that if an unjust judge would reward persistence, how much more God will respond to those who ask of him. I wonder also if we are also being encouraged to be like that widow, to never give up asking for things from God. She was strong, determined and persistent. This attitude is echoed in the first reading when Jacob wrestles with God, almost to the death. Prayer is clearly a struggle. We must never lose heart. Is it in wrestling with God that we discover an answer to our prayer?

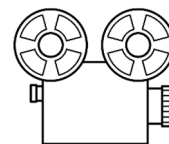

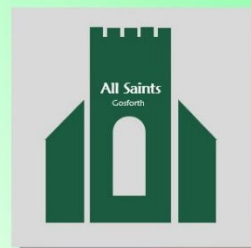
