### From the Vicar

Dear All,

The rules of the current national lockdown allow public worship to continue in churches and other places of worship. However, bearing in mind the seriousness of the situation, we have decided to close the church for all public worship (with the exception of funerals). So please, stay at home and join us online for services (details below).

We much regret this decision after working so hard to ensure worship is as safe as it could possibly be, and we know just how important attendance at church, fellowship and receiving communion is to many. At the same time, we have to acknowledge that the NHS is under great pressure and the way each of us can help is to stay at home, both to avoid the risk of infection and any accidents which might require hospitalisation.

We are still very much a functioning church and continue to pray for all those affected by the pandemic, those unwell and their families and supporters. We also give thanks for the courage, skill and dedication of medical and nursing staff and all who are giving themselves generously to care for others in such anxious times.

## Thought for the day

Two of our readings this morning describe events where the veil between heaven and earth is drawn aside and the participants are given an insight into things beyond normal earthly experience.

At Christmas we celebrated Jesus coming to earth in the flesh like one of us and at the Transfiguration the disciples caught a glimpse of the divine Jesus – no doubt a great encouragement to them as they struggled to understand the teaching and example of this enigmatic and challenging figure and may have wondered if they had been wise in giving up so much to follow him.

There are several insights that we might gain from this event. One is that while we might all long for extraordinary spiritual experiences, what is important is not to stay on the mountaintop (and Peter wants to capture the experience by building a memorial there) but to use the experience in how we act when we return to earth. Another is that what has changed or been transformed is not Jesus – he was always divine – but the disciples' perception and this should encourage us to look on everything with new eyes, as being filled with God's presence.

There is much discussion about how life has changed for us in the last year and what things might be like when the present crisis is over but perhaps we will have learned to look on things differently, to appreciate what really matters and to see new possibilities.
